



## Go Flying Event



**When:** Saturday, September 26, 2009 - 8:00am

**Where:** Manassas Regional Airport, VA [Click here to see a Google map](#)

\* The airport is about 30 minutes from South Riding.

**Purpose:** Go flying around Manassas and neighboring cities. Cub Scouts regulations limit the flying distance to 25 nautical miles from the departure point. The pilots will only be allowed to depart and land from the Manassas Regional Airport.

**Cost:** The cost will be calculated based on the number of people and flights taken. An estimate was done and it seems that it will be between \$10-\$20 per person.

**Pilots:** Three pilots volunteered for this event. The planes that will be available are:

1. Beech S-35 Bonanza
2. Piper Arrow P28R-200
3. Cessna TR182
